## 2025-2026 Tuition and Fee Schedule

### **Registration Fee** - Due at time of registration, must apply annually

All grades annually (K-12<sup>th</sup>) - \$150.00 or \$200.00 per family

### **Technology Fee**

All grades annually (K-12<sup>th</sup>) - \$150 per student, \$250 max per family  
(parent internet access to MySchoolWorx to view child's grades, discipline, etc.)

**Yearbook Fee** - \$45 per student (if you order it by the deadline)

**Standardized Testing Fee** - \$50 per student

### **Book / Supply Fee** - Half of the book fee is due August 1, Balance due September 1

The book/supply fee will cover textbooks, special classes for elementary, t-shirt and shorts for PE and play time dress/field trips, student accident insurance, and sports accident insurance.

Kindergarten	\$ <u>350</u> (an additional \$ <u>50</u> graduation fee due by 2/1/2024)
Elementary (1 <sup>st</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> )	\$ <u>475</u>
Middle School (6 <sup>th</sup> -8 <sup>th</sup> )	\$ <u>500</u>
High School (9 <sup>th</sup> -12 <sup>th</sup> )	\$ <u>600</u> (12 <sup>th</sup> gr. – additional \$ <u>150</u> graduation fee due by 2/1/2024)
High School Retreat	\$ <u>75</u> (Required for grades 9 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup> )

**\*Tuition** - Annual or broken into 10 or 12 equal monthly payments due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month, starting either June 1 or August 1 and ending May 1

Early Learning (K-3 <sup>rd</sup> )	\$ <u>6,000</u> / yr. (or \$ <u>600</u> per month)
Upper Elementary (4 <sup>th</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> )	\$ <u>5,770</u> / yr. (or \$ <u>577</u> per month)
Middle School (6 <sup>th</sup> -8 <sup>th</sup> )	\$ <u>6,220</u> / yr. (or \$ <u>622</u> per month)
High School (9 <sup>th</sup> -12 <sup>th</sup> )	\$ <u>7,030</u> / yr. (or \$ <u>703</u> per month)

### **Exceptional Student Education Program**

All Grades (self-contained classrooms with teacher/aide) \$9,500 / yr. (or \$950 per month)

### **Scholarships**

**We accept the following scholarships:**

- **Step Up for Students** – income-based scholarship – [www.stepupforstudents.org](http://www.stepupforstudents.org)
  - **Family Empowerment – Educational Options (FES-EO)**
  - **Family Empowerment – Unique Abilities (FES-UA)** - based on qualifying diagnoses including ASD/Asperger's syndrome, emotional, speech impairment, and hearing impairment. IEP not necessary, but needed if student has one.
  - **Florida Tax Credit (FTC)** – income-based scholarship.
  - **Hope Scholarship** – For students who have been bullied in public school.

**Tutoring Available** - \$20 per hour, up to two hours per week for 36 weeks

**Daily Bus Transportation Rates** - \$1,700 round-trip, \$900 1-way per child per year.
